**Tenth National Youth Parliament Competition for Universities/Colleges, 2010-2011.**

1. **Objective:** With a view to strengthen the system of parliamentary democracy, create democratic awareness and imbibe democratic ethos among the youth by acquainting them about the functioning of our representative institutions, Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs will hold Tenth Inter-University Youth Parliament Competition during **2010-2011**.
2. **Eligibility:** All the recognized Universities/Deemed universities either directly or through any one of the affiliated colleges are eligible to participate in the Competition. However, final selection of University for the purpose would be made by the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs. (Direct request from any College for participation in the competition will not be entertained)
3. **Manner of holding the Competition:** Universities/Institutions selected for the purpose would be divided into Groups. The Competition will be held in two levels - (i) Group level and (ii) National level. At the Group Level, the Competition will be conducted among the Institutions in each Group. Thereafter, the National Level Competition will be conducted, wherein the group winners of various Groups will compete.
4. **Nomination of co-ordinator:** The University/Institution may nominate one co-ordinator, who will organize Youth Parliament in that University, and communicate his name, designation, address and telephone and fax numbers to this Ministry latest by **30.11.2009**. **Students are not entitled to act as co-ordinators.**
5. **Orientation Course:** In order to acquaint the co-ordinators of the Universities with procedures/practices of conducting Youth Parliament, this Ministry will organize an Orientation Course at a suitable place in **January, 2010**. Exact schedule of the Orientation Course would be intimated to the concerned University/College and the coordinators.
6. **T.A., D.A and Stay of Participants:** This Ministry will make arrangements for free boarding/lodging of the participants attending the Orientation Course. The Ministry will provide actual train/bus fare maximum up to the II AC train fare, as TA to the participants. **The amount of TA will be reimbursed only on production of original tickets and a certificate to the effect that the participant has not claimed any TA/DA from his/her parent institution for those days/purpose.**
7. **Financial Assistance:** This Ministry will reimburse expenses incurred by each Institution up to Rs.10,000/- for participating at each level of Youth Parliament Competition on production of original vouchers/bills etc. as per the scheme.

8. **Schedule of Competition:** The Competition will be conducted as per the following schedule to be followed strictly:-

- (i) Date of receipt of application for participating in Youth Parliament Competition - 15.11.2009
- (ii) Orientation Course of 2 days - To be held during January,2010
- (iii) Group Level Competition - To be completed by February,2010  
(within one month of the date of Orientation Course)
- (iv) National Level Competition - To be completed upto April, 2010
- (v) Prize Distribution Function - To be held during August, 2010

9. **Evaluation of the Competition:** The performance of Youth Parliament Competitions will be evaluated by a team consisting of:

- (i) MP/Ex-MP/MLA/Ex-MLA/MLC/Ex-MLC, Group Co-ordinator and an academician of repute from a non-participating institution at Group Level and
- (ii) an MP/Ex-MP/MLA/Ex-MLA/MLC/Ex-MLC, an officer of the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs, and an academician of repute from a non-participating institution at National Level.

10. **Trophies/Prizes and Certificates:** The Ministry will award Prizes and Certificates to the students, certificates to the teachers-in-charge of the Youth Parliament team and trophies to Universities/Institution for their meritorious performances, in a Prize Distribution Function on completion of the Youth Parliament Competition in all the participating institutions.

The Universities/Deemed Universities/Institutions, which are interested in participating in the Competition, may write through their Vice-Chancellor/Registrar in the proforma enclosed to the R.C.
