

PRESS RELEASE

The Monsoon Session, 2010 of Parliament (5th Session of Fifteenth Lok Sabha and the 220th Session of the Rajya Sabha) is scheduled to commence on Monday, the 26th of July, 2010 and subject to exigencies of Government Business, the Session will conclude on Friday, the 27th of August, 2010. The Session will provide 24 sittings spread over a period of 33 days.

2. The Session will mainly be devoted to essential Government legislative and other business, including financial business relating to Supplementary Demands for Grants for the year 2010-11 in respect of Railway and General Budgets and Supplementary Demands for Grants of the State of Jharkhand for the year 2010-11.

3. To finalise the Government Business for the Monsoon Session, 2010, Minister of Parliamentary Affairs took a meeting with the Secretaries/Senior Officers of the various Ministries/Departments on Tuesday, the 20th of July, 2010. The Minister of State in the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs co-chaired the meeting.
