1. Important Policy Decisions/Major Achievements during the Month:-

• Implementation of Assurances in Parliament

At the end of the month of March, 2024, 660 Assurances of Lok Sabha and 661 Assurances of Rajya Sabha were pending. During the month, 27 Assurances were added at the instance of committee on Government Assurances Lok Sabha while 20 Assurances were added at the instance of Committee on Government Assurances Rajya Sabha..

During the month of March, 2024 names of 03 Members of Parliament were deleted from the list of the Consultative Committee after their death/resignation/retirement. The details in respect of above are given at Annexure - I.

- c. In the month of March, 2024 total 176 new registrations from various Educational institutions were made on the NYPS portal. 46 institutions have fully or partially uploaded photographs, videos, report, student details etc on NYPS portal after conducting the Youth Parliament sitting.

Sitting of Official Language Implementation Committee was organised successfully on 22.03.2024 under the chairmanship of Addl. Secretary, MoPA

• National e-Vidhan Application (NeVA)

During the month of March, 2024 the following activities were undertaken on NeVA front:

(1) Audit of NeVA Project of Sikkim and Nagaland Legislative Assembly

The Internal Audit Wing of the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions has completed Audits of the NeVA Project at the Sikkim and Nagaland Legislative Assemblies. The Audits were conducted from 4th to 7th March, 2024 at Sikkim Legislative Assembly and from 7th to 9th March 2024 at Nagaland Legislative Assembly.

(2) Orientation Training Programme on NeVA in Assam Legislative Assembly

Assam Legislative Assembly had signed MoU with MoPA to adopt NeVA on 22.02.2024 and became 23rd legislature in the country to transform itself into a digital house by embracing NeVA. Accordingly, 2 days Orientation Training on NeVA was conducted at Assam Legislative Assembly on 18th & 19th March, 2024 for the officers of the Secretariat.

(3) Live house sessions held through NeVA

During the month, following sessions were held through NeVA application: -

- 1. The Budget Session of Tripura Legislative Assembly was held from 1st March, 2024 to 5th March, 2024
- 2. The Budget Session of Punjab Legislative Assembly was held from 1st March, 2024 to 15th March, 2024

(4) Demonstration of NeVA portal to Rajya Sabha

The Committee on Information and Communication Technology Management in the Rajya Sabha directed the Rajya Sabha Secretariat to arrange a demonstration of different modules of NeVA from MoPA, with the aim of assessing the application's suitability for use within the Rajya Sabha. Accordingly, the NeVA demonstration took place on 7th March, 2024.

(5) Training cum Workshop for Bihar Legislative Assembly

A three-day training program on different modules of NeVA was conducted for the officials of the Bihar Legislative Assembly at CPMU, Annexe Extension Building, New Delhi from 11th March to 13th March, 2024.

(6) Release of funds for legislatures

1. The 3rd instalment of the Central Share amounting to Rs <u>1,72,42,389/- (Rupees One Crore Seventy Two Lakh Forty Two Thousand Three Hundred Eighty Nine only)</u> was released to Manipur Legislative Assembly for the implementation of NeVA project on 26.03.2024.

(7) Virtual conferences on NeVA

1. NeVA team organized a virtual conference on 26.03.2024 with the CEO of Bhasini, MeitY to review the integration of APIs on NeVA application to facilitate real time voice-to-text multi language translation, real time voice to voice multi language translation and comprehensive multi language translation of NeVA website.

(8) Enhancing Accessibility: - NeVA Public Portal's Multilingual Text Translation Integration

1. The integration of text translation support into 23 languages on the NeVA Public Portal is a major achievement for the NeVA project. This enhancement improves accessibility for stakeholders from diverse linguistic backgrounds, addressing a key barrier to information access. It demonstrates the project's commitment to inclusivity, ensuring all stakeholders can benefit regardless of language proficiency. It reflects the project's dedication to leveraging technology to bridge communication gaps and promote transparency and efficiency in governance processes.

(9) Technical support extended to Legislative Assemblies for running sessions on NeVA

- A). A technical team from CPMU was stationed at the Punjab Legislative Assembly from 1st March to 15th March, 2024 to provide necessary technical support and assistance that the Assembly required for running the budget session smoothly through NeVA.
- B). A technical team from CPMU was deputed to provide online technical support to Tripura Legislative Assembly for running the budget session smoothly through NeVA, from 1st March to 5th March, 2024.
