3. The Hon'ble President may address both Houses of Parliament assembled together at 11:00 am on Tuesday, the 31st January, 2023; and
4. The Union Budget for 2023-24 may be presented in Lok Sabha on Wednesday, the 1st February, 2023 at 11:00 Hours and after presentation/laying of the budget, the respective Houses may be adjourned for the day.
