• **Meeting of Cabinet Committee on Parliamentary Affairs (CCPA)**

The Cabinet Committee on Parliamentary Affairs held a meeting on 19th June, 2023, to consider Note No 04/2023 dated 19th June, 2023 regarding summoning of Monsoon Session, 2023 and approved that both Houses of Parliament may be summoned for its Monsoon Session, 2023 on Thursday, the 20th July, 2023, and subject to exigencies of Government Business, the Session may conclude on Friday, the 11th August, 2023.

At the end of the month of June, 2023, 838 (including 54 Assurances added at the instance of Committee on Government Assurance, Lok Sabha) Assurance of Lok Sabha and 665 Assurances of Rajya Sabha were pending.
