## NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 2nd November, 2010

- G.S.R. 895(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs, Deputy Secretary Recruitment Rules, 2002 except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Deputy Secretary in the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs, namely:—
- Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs, Deputy Secretary Recruitment Rules, 2010.
  - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- Number of posts, classification and pay band and grade pay/Scale of pay.—The number of the posts, its
  classification and the Pay Band and Grade Pay or Pay Scale attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the
  Schedule annexed hereto.
- Methods of recruitment, age limit and qualifications, etc.—The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications
  and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (14) of the said Schedule.
  - 4. Disqualifications.-No person,-
    - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
    - (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- 5. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provision of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- 9. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affects reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-servicemen and other special category of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

**Promotion:** Under Secretary in the scale of pay of Rs. 15600-39100 with grade pay of Rs. 6600 in Pay Band-3 with five years regular service in the grade.

Note 1: Where juniors who have completed their qualifying/eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying/eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying/eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with their juniors who have completed such qualifying/eligibility service.

Note 2: For the purpose of computing minimum qualifying service for promotion, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1st January of 2006, the date from which the revised pay structure based on the 6th Central Pay Commission recommendations has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding scale of pay or grade pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the Pay Commission except where there has been merger of more than one pre-revised scale of pay into one grade with a common grade pay/pay scale, and where this benefit will extend only for the post(s) for which that grade pay/pay scale is the normal replacement grade without any upgradation.

## Deputation:

Officers under the Central/State Government/Union Territories:—

- (a) (i) holding analogous post on regular basis in the parent cadre/ Department; or
- (ii) with five years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in the scale of pay of Rs. 15600-39100 with grade pay Rs. 6600 in Pay Band-3 or equivalent in the parent cadre/ Department; and
- (b) Possessing ten years of experience in administration including three year experience in Parliamentary or Legislative functions.
- Note 1: The departmental Officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationist shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.
- Note 2: Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization/department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years.

Note 3: The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding fifty six years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.

Note 4: For the purpose of appointment on deputation basis, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1st January of 2006 (the date from which the revised pay structure based on the 6th Central Pay Commission recommendation has been extended) shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade pay/pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the pay commission except where there has been merger of more than one pre-revised scale of pay into one grade with a common grade pay/pay scale, and where this benefit will extend only for the post(s) for which that grade pay/pay scale is the normal replacement grade without any upgradation.
