e-Vidhan is a Mission Mode Project to digitize and make the functioning of State Legislatures paperless. This is part of the broader Digital India Programme which is a high priority programme of the Government of India. Himachal Pradesh Assembly is the first one which has already become paperless.

Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs is the Nodal Ministry for e-Vidhan Project. The Ministry is taking all the necessary steps for rolling out the Project in all the States at an early date.

One of the key component of the strategy devised for implementation of the project is to create Project Monitoring Units both at Central as well as State level.

Since, digitization of the State Legislatures is likely to contribute to the cleanliness & environment by reducing the use of papers to a great extent, therefore keeping in view the objective of Swachhata Pakhwada being observed by the Ministry from 16th to 30th April, 2018, new office of Central Project Monitoring Unit (CPMU), e-Vidhan has been set up at First Floor in Parliament House Annexe, New Delhi.
